

I'M EXTREMELY PROUD OF OUR PLAYERS THROUGHOUT THE SEASON, AND THERE WERE STAGES DURING OUR GRAND FINAL THAT FORRESTDALE COULD HAVE RUN AWAY FROM US, BUT IN TYPICAL FASHION THE PLAYERS SHOWED ENORMOUS HEART AND CHARACTER TO KEEP CHIPPING AWAY AND WE TRAILED BY JUST 8POINTS AT 3/4TIME. WHAT A SEASON! A SEASON ALL PLAYERS, SUPPORTERS AND OUR ENIGNATIC COACH BILL BRANDSMA CAN BE PROUD OF.

WE STARTED OF THE SEASON WITH SOME HUGE WINS GIVING CONFIDENCE TO ONE AND ALL, WITH A SPRINKLING OF YOUTH AND EXPERIENCED PLAYERS DEMOLISHING TEAMS AT WILL. THEN AFTER A BYE IN ROUND 4 WE MET BALCATTA AT THE HUGE JONES PASKIN RESERVE WHERE WE WERE TAUGHT A FOOTBALL LESSON. BRUISED AND BATTERED WE LIMPED HOME WITH A FIFTEEN GOAL DEFEAT UNDER OUR WING.

OUR FIRST FINALS GAME WAS AGAINST BALCATTA AT BALCATTA AND ONCE AGAIN WE WERE BEATEN DUE TO A LACK OF DISIPLINE AND CONCETRATION BY SOME SENIOR PLAYERS WHO SHOULD HAVE KNOWN BETTER.

WAS IT GOING TO HAPPEN AGAIN? WOULD WE EVER WIN A FINALS GAME FOR BILLY? THE ANSWER WAS YES. THE WEEK AFTER WE FACED CARLISLE AT SELBY PARK, THE BOYS CLICKED AND WE LIVED TO FIGHT ANOTHER WEEK. WITH A COMPREHENSIVE WIN OVER CARLISLE, BALCATTA AGAIN.

WE PLAYED BALCATTA AT BAYSWATER OVAL, THE WINNER TO FACE FORRESTDALE IN THE GRAND FINAL. WITH A HUGE CROWD TO CHEER US ON THE BOYS RIPPED BALCATTA APART. THE YOUNG BLOKES SUCH AS ROBBIE ROWLANDS, SCOTTY BAKER, CHRIS PAYNE AND WAYNE ALFORD REALLY LEADING THE WAY AND FIGHTING HARD TO WIN THE BALL.
