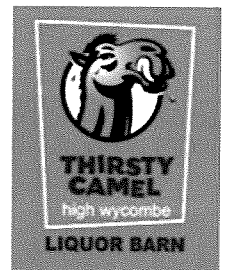

HALL OF FAME 2015

The High Wycombe football club Hall of Fame seeks to recognise and enshrine players, coaches, trainers and administrators that have made significant contribution to the club.

The inductees to the High Wycombe Amateur Football club Hall of Fame are:

Chris McDonnell "Macca"

Macca a booming left footer began is playing days at High Wycombe as a 17 year old back in 1997. He played in the senior sides until in 1999 he became one of the founding members of the club's inaugural Colts team.

Macca is the current games played record holder for High Wycombe playing 264 games and is likely to be the first player to reach the 300 game milestone. Macca's achievements at the club are:

2003 he was a Premiership player with the C Reserve side

2009 he was a Premiership player with the C Reserves side

Robert "Pud" Meikle

Pud began his WAAFL career with the Redcliffe Amateur Football Club in the mid 80's where he played in excess of 175 games over 11 seasons. He had a bit of legendary status prior to joining

the High Wycombe football club with his achievements at Redcliffe, these achievements include:

Association F&B 1985 and the clubs fairest and best for that year.

Captained his side in 1985 and 1986 losing both grand finals after being undefeated all season.

Began his coaching as a 24 year old in 1989, in 6 seasons he remarkably played and coached his team to 4 consecutive Premierships.

Pud joined the High Wycombe football club in 1996, coaching and playing for 7 seasons until 2002. His achievements at the club are:

Coached and played the I Grade to a grand final in 1996

Took over as senior coach of the D grade side in 1997 finishing 3rd

Coached D Reserve to a premiership in 1998

Took D Reserve into another Grand Final in 1999

Won the D Reserve Fairest and Best in 1999

Coached the 2000 to 2002 C Reserve sides finishing 4th 5th and 4th respectively

Pud is equal third in the highest number of seasons coached along with inaugural coach Ross Fitzgerald

Pud ended his Amateur football career having played in excess of 320 games.

Phil Sheedy "Mr Sheeds"

Mr Sheeds as he is known began as a trainer for the club in 1995 starting out with the clubs third senior side. In 1997 he became the trainer for both the top two senior sides.

Every Tuesday and Thursday training nights Mr Sheeds would be there without fail and was also doing the games on the Saturday. This was a massive effort with the work load and also back then the only remuneration received was enough to cover fuel.

He continued as Senior Trainer until early 2000 before moving to Jurian Bay. In late 2000, Mr Sheeds returned to the club where he continued as a trainer for a couple more years.

Mr Sheeds is highly regarded as a great club person and in recognition the Club Person of the Year award is named after him as a testimony to the respect he holds at the club.

Shane Sterrett "Sterro"

Sterro was one of the real characters of the High Wycombe football club, he was always up for a laugh and there were many entertaining boozy nights at the club when he was around.

Sterro was an inaugural part of the club, he was one of the first to achieve the 200 game milestone and ending his playing days on 213 games. His achievements for the club are as follows:

1995 he was a Premiership player in the clubs inaugural premiership side

1996 he won the Fairest and Best for I Grade in the year they made the Grand Final

1998 a Premiership player with the D Reserves

1999 he won the Fairest and Best for D Reserve again that year they made the Grand Final.

2000 he won the Association's Fairest and Best for "C" Reserve

2001 he was the Captain for the C Reserve side

2003 he coached the E Grade side finishing a respectable 3rd

2004 a Premiership player with the F troop side

Chris Wood "Woody"

Woody was a towering ruck man, giving our onballers great service with his taps. Woody was strong in the ruck and was a solid target taking strong marks around the ground. Some of the tackles he laid were amongst the best, many a time the opposition player would have to leave the ground. Woody's achievement for the club are:

Played a total of 157 games. (There is talk of coming out of retirement)

1996 he won the Association Fairest and Best for "I" Grade and also played in the Grand Final that year

1999 he was a Premiership Player with the D Grade side

2002 he was the Fairest and Best for the C Reserves

2003 he was a Premiership Player with the C Reserve side

2004 he was a Premiership Player with the F Troop side
